Notes For Guidance

Please read these notes carefully and sign the declaration on the front before returning the form.

- Training is offered on the basis of one handler, one dog. Neither place is transferable.
- Training fees are payable in advance and are not refundable in the event of absence.
- **A dog/bitch must not be brought to training if**
 - * It is a bitch in season
 - * It is suffering from (or in contact with) a contagious disease, within three weeks of that event.
- Handlers undertake to ensure that any dog they bring to the training venue is vaccinated or currently homoeopathically protected against distemper, viral hepatitis, leptospirosis and canine parvovirus.
- Spectators are welcome to watch the training but must remain outside the training barn at all times. Children under 12 must be closely supervised at all times by a responsible, non-training adult.
- Fortunately accidents in dog training and agility are extremely rare. However in common with all sports and canine activities there are inherent risks, which in signing the declaration overleaf you fully acknowledge. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken regarding the safety of dogs, handlers and personal property whilst at the training venue, neither Thatcham DTC nor any associated individual or collective will accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to dogs, people or property, however caused. Applicants are strongly advised to make insurance arrangements to their own satisfaction before commencing training.
- Please provide your full contact details overleaf, including your mobile phone number. For your safety, your application will not be accepted without at least one valid ICE number.
ICE stands for **In Case of Emergency**. Your ICE number is stored securely and purely for your welfare. Your ICE number must be the phone number of a trusted friend or relative who we can contact to attend the venue, collect your dog(s) and supervise your care and/or treatment, should you be incapacitated in any way whilst at training. You may submit as many ICE numbers as you wish. Please seek your ICE nominee's permission to use their number in this way, and their agreement that they'll be available to answer their phone for this purpose, at the times you're at the venue.

Please print both pages. Complete page one, sign the declaration, and bring it with you to your first lesson. Keep page two for your own reference. Thank you!

Please bring with you to training:

A lead and a flat collar - collar: clip-release or buckle but NO check-chains or half-checks

A special toy or tuggy for reward playing and retrieving (to be kept separate from other toys and only used as a reward while working)

Loads of tiny titbits - human food is best - diced cheese, sausage, ham etc

A sense of humour - agility training should be FUN for you AND your dog!
